Members and Exhibitors of Berkeley's First Art Colony (1906-1911)

What follows is a compilation of the painters, etchers, ceramicists, sculptors and art photographers with their exhibitions. As defined in the Introduction, "Members" of the art colony not only exhibit and conduct their professional work in Berkeley, but they also reside in that community or its immediate environs. They are catalogued by their names, periods of affiliation with Berkeley and specialties. If an artist was also a teacher, then the title of the Berkeley institution is included: University of California = UC; California School of Arts and Crafts = CSAC; The Associated Studios (originally the Berkeley School of Art) = AST; and private art schools (including instruction in studios) = PAS. For each female artist who married (or remarried) *after* 1905 her husband's surname will be inserted in brackets "()". Those designated as "Exhibitors" have merely sent paintings for display in Berkeley and few have even visited the town. They are included on a single line with only their name and city of most recent California residence in square brackets "[]". A deceased artist is noted by "†". A biographical reference is placed at the far right; Volume 1 and Volume 2 refer to this publication.

In addition to all craftsmen and amateur photographers, I have excluded two talented Berkeley artists, George Henry Goddard (1817-1906) and John P. White (18??-1907), because illness and death did not allow their participation in the art colony (Albert Shumate, *The Life of George Henry Goddard*, Berkeley, 1969, pp.11ff; BDG, December 28, 1906, p.1; SFC, December 29, 1906, p.13; BKI, June 7, 1907, p.1). J. F. Raphael, who opened an "art studio and school of design" in Berkeley's Francis Shattuck Building on January 14, 1906 and permanently left four months later, is not discussed here (BKR: January 6, 1906, p.3; January 17, 1906, p.7; January 26, 1906, p.7; February 1, 1906, p.7; April 27, 1906, p.5).

In most cases the list of exhibitors is derived from newspaper reviews, which are appended to each of the eighteen events below, and may not be complete. The only surviving catalogues, and consequently the only official inventories for the titles of exhibited works, are those of the Studio Building Exhibition in 1906 and of the Second Annual at the Berkeley Art Association in 1908. Because these titles have already been published by Ellen Halteman Schwartz, they are normally not repeated in the biography on each artist (Appendix 7). Solo or paired "public exhibitions" given outside of private studios are in category No.9. All of the exhibitions cited below were juried, except for Nos. 6, 8, and 9.
